Dear MP

There are 120 hostages still being held in Gaza by terrorists. They are without proper medication, food and sanitary conditions. The ICRC have not been allowed to access the hostages as per the Geneva Conventions. According to the UN there are credible reports that some are being sexually abused. Released hostages have testified that sexual violence and torture is happening. Many have been murdered in captivity.

Six of those held are British or connected to the UK. I am deeply worried about theirs and all the hostages' precarious situation. Can you tell me what you have been doing to raise concerns in Parliament? What pressure have you exerted on countries like Qatar, Egypt and the USA who play an important role in negotiations?

I look forward to hearing your response promptly as time is running out for them.
